Fossil Vocabulary

- Sedimentary Rock: layer of Earth where most fossils are found because they get buried ,
- 2. Extinct: Describes a group of things that are no longer living
- 3. <u>Imprint Fossil:</u> Also known as a trace fossil, this is the footprint an animal leaves behind in mud which becomes a fossil over time
- 4. Mold: The shape of a plant or animal that was left in sediment (think of what the seashell left in the playdough).
- 5. Petrified Wood: A type of fossil in which wood has turned to stone.
- 6. <u>Cast:</u> A type of fossil that is formed when mud or minerals fill a mold and looks exactly like the plant or animal (think of the dried glue).
- 7. Fossil: The hardened remains of a living thing that died a long time ago.
- 8. Amber: An insect gets stuck in tree sap and the sap hardened
